

# Our Responsibility Garden

## THE CARELESS CLEANUP

### Materials:

- Large sheet of paper or poster board.
- Colored markers or crayons.
- Tape or glue.
- Construction paper flowers and stems.
- A Bible.

### Directions:

1. Read Galatians 6:5 aloud as a family. Discuss what it might mean to “be responsible for yourself.”
2. Next, cut out construction paper flowers and green construction paper stems. Make sure the stems are big enough to write on.
3. On the flower stems, have family members write a different responsibility they will take care of. Examples:
  - I will help clean up my room.
  - I will be kind with my words.
  - I will take care of my health.
  - I will do my homework on time.
4. Create a beautiful responsibility garden by taping or gluing them to your poster board. Place it on a wall where everyone will see it.
