

Freedom Freeze Tag

— AMERICA'S GRATEFUL STATEFUL ROAD TRIP —

HOW TO PLAY

Today, you will become Freedom Heroes through a game of old-fashioned tag, but with a twist. In this game, you'll have one person who's the Freedom Chaser. If the Freedom Chaser tags you, you must freeze. Your teammates must unfreeze you by getting the correct facts about American history, landmarks, and presidents. Who will be the fastest Freedom Hero to save their friends from being frozen again and again?

1. Divide the players into teams and designate one person as the Freedom Chaser and another as the host of the Freedom Freeze Tag. This person will ask the teams the questions.
2. When the Freedom Chaser tags you, freeze in place.
3. To get unfrozen, another teammate must tag you and answer the question given by the Freedom Freeze Tag Host. If you are correct, you are unfrozen and can run around again. If you are incorrect, you both stay frozen until another team member arrives and correctly answers a question.
4. Keep playing until everyone has been tagged, or set a timer.

There are questions on the next page to help guide you through the game. If you need more questions, players can yell out cities and states.

EXAMPLE QUESTIONS TO ASK

- **What city has the Liberty Bell?** Philadelphia
- **Which president is on the \$1 bill?** George Washington
- **Which president is on the \$5 bill?** Abraham Lincoln
- **How many stars are on the flag?** 50
- **How many stripes are on the flag?** 13
- **What animal is the symbol of the United States?** Eagle
- **Who was the first president of the United States?** George Washington
- **Which president wrote the Declaration of Independence?** Thomas Jefferson
- **In which city is the Statue of Liberty located?** New York City
- **What mountain has four presidents carved in it?** Mount Rushmore
- **What colors are the American flag?** Red, white, and blue
- **What do we call the song that starts with the line: "Oh, say can you see?"** "The Star-Spangled Banner" or the national anthem
- **What document starts with the phrase: "We the People..."** The United States Constitution
- **What do Americans usually watch in the sky on the 4th of July?** Fireworks
- **What sport is called America's favorite pastime?** Baseball
- **What house does the president live in?** The White House
- **What holiday do we celebrate on America's Independence Day?** 4th of July
- **Who is the woman many people say sewed the first American Flag?** Betsy Ross
- **What do the 13 stripes in our flag represent?** The 13 colonies
